Interior walls have nearly always been decorated. From as early as the 15th century series of panels were set into molded frameworks arranged on interior walls. Originally, paneling was used as a means to seal a room from cold drafts, but almost immediately became showcase for craftsmanship, with artistic expression reaching its peak in the 18th century.

Throughout history various forms of lining interior walls with wooden treatment has changed from one dominate form to another. Each has its own character that lends to the unique ambiance of a wooden room.

We specialize in assisting you to select and create just the right look. Drawing from a wide selection of wood species coupled with various methods of installation—from wainscot to the full height of the wall—we offer tongue and groove v-jointed, butt-jointed and bead board paneling, raised panel wall systems, recessed flat panel wall systems, rough-sawn plank boards, log siding, and other options only limited by your imagination.





For raised and flat panel walls, we have expert craftsmen available to assist to layout and design wall systems that can be prefabricated in our mill with rails, stiles and panels ready to assemble on the job site. Furniture-grade factory finishing is also available upon request.

All of our 3/4"-thick tongue & grooved paneling is end-matched and finished on both sides. We use hand-selected furniture-grade wood that is kiln dried to less than 7-8% moisture content.

WOOD & Co. paneling is available commonly in 3, 5, and 7" widths (3-7" for Heart Pine), and wider boards available up to 11" for many species on request. Most of our species are available in flat-sawn and quarter-sawn boards.

Installers love us for our quality and material dimensions. In lengths up to 16 feet, the average board length is 6 to 9 feet long. Our short boards are often equal to our competition's longer boards. Thus, creating a more attractive wall with fewer horizontal end joints.
